6. Nature of contract

Global price.

7. Contract description

The purposes of this contract are as follows: Purpose 1: Support activity 2.1. Setting up Marine Biodiversity Conservation Center “Boka Aquarium”, sub-activity 2.1.3. Adaptation of ground floor of Institute for Marine Biology (reconstruction and restoring the Aquarium) in line with Montenegrin Law on Spatial Planning and Construction (LSPC).

8. Number and titles of lots

One lot only.

9. Maximum budget

12,000 EUR.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

10. Eligibility

Participation in tendering is open on equal terms to legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union, in a Candidate Countries¹ or in a country of the European Economic Area (EEA).

11. Number of tenders

No more than one tender can be submitted by a natural or legal person whatever the form of participation (as an individual legal entity or as leader or member of a consortium submitting a tender). In the event that a natural or legal person submits more than one tender, all tenders in which that person has participated will be excluded.

12. Grounds for exclusion

As part of the tender, tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the tender form, to the effect that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.3. of the Practical Guide.

13. Sub-contracting

Subcontracting is allowed.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

The following selection criteria will be applied to the tenderers. In the case of tenders submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole. If not specified otherwise. The selection criteria will not be applied to natural persons and single-member companies when they are sub-contractors.

1) Economic and financial capacity of the tenderer (based on item 3 of the tender form). In case of tenderer being a public body, equivalent information should be provided. The reference

period which will be taken into account will be the last three years for which accounts have been closed.

- Tenderer (i.e., the consortium as a whole, in the case of a tender from a consortium): will not be economically dependent on the Contracting Authority in the event that the contract is awarded to it; and has sufficient financial stability to handle the proposed contract, confirmed by:
 - Annual turnover in the year before last year and in the last year at least 14,000 EUR (exceeding the annualised maximum budget of the contract)
 - Current ratio (current assets/current liabilities) in the last year at least 1

2) Professional capacity of the tenderer (based on items 4 of the tender form).

The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last three years from submission deadline.

- Tenderer (i.e., the consortium as a whole, in the case of a tender from a consortium) has sufficient ongoing staff resources and expertise to be able to handle the proposed contract, and is not a so-called 'body shop', i.e. a tenderer with no real expertise in fields related to the contract but which simply identifies and proposes experts to fit the project description, confirmed by:
 - Permanent staff in the past and current year: at least 8, out of which 6 relevant architects in the field of architectural concepts and projects development
 - Relevant staff in the past and current year: at least 2 economists in the field of budgeting for architectural concepts and projects

3) Technical capacity of candidate (based on items 5 and 6 of the tender form). The reference period which will be taken into account will be the last three years from submission deadline.

- Tenderer (i.e., the consortium as a whole, in the case of a tender from a consortium) has sufficient expertise and experience to be able to handle the proposed contract, confirmed by:
 - Experience in planning scientific and research facilities (e.g. laboratories)
 - Experience in planning in protected areas (e.g. Directorate for the Protection of Cultural Property and/or UNESCO)
 - Experience in planning stone buildings in protected areas (e.g. Directorate for the Protection of Cultural Property and/or UNESCO)
 - Experience in planning for reconstruction projects of buildings of particular importance for Montenegro

Previous experience which would have led to breach of contract and termination by a Contracting Authority shall not be used as reference. This is also applicable concerning the previous experience of experts required under a fee-based service contract.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the Contracting Authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing a commitment on the part of those entities

to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility - notably that of nationality - and must fulfil the same relevant selection criteria as the economic operator. With regard to technical and professional criteria, an economic operator may only rely on the capacities of other entities where the latter will perform the works or services for which these capacities are required. With regard to economic and financial criteria, the entities upon whose capacity the tenderer relies, become jointly and severally liable for the performance of the contract.

17. Award criteria

Best price-quality ratio.

18. Deadline for receipt of tenders

The deadline for receipt of tenders is specified in point 8 of the Instruction to Tenderers.

19. Tender format and details to be provided

Tenders must be submitted using the standard tender form for Competitive Negotiated Procedures, the format and instructions of which must be strictly observed. The tender form is available from the following Internet address:

Any additional documentation (brochure, letter, etc.) sent with a tender will not be taken into consideration.

20. How tenders may be submitted

Tenders must be submitted in English exclusively to the Contracting Authority, using the means specified in point 8 of the Instructions to Tenderers.

Tenders submitted by any other means will not be considered.

By submitting a tender tenderers accept to receive notification of the outcome of the procedure by electronic means.

21. Alteration or withdrawal of tenders

Tenderers may alter or withdraw their tenders by written notification prior to the deadline for submission of tenders. No tender may be altered after this deadline.

Any such notification of alteration or withdrawal shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with point 8 of the Instructions to Tenderers. The outer envelope (and the relevant inner envelope if used) must be marked 'Alteration' or 'Withdrawal' as appropriate.

22. Operational language

All written communications for this tender procedure and contract must be in English.

23. Legal basis
